How often do you get the chance to turn up and sing any one of these great choral works? Join Hertfordshire Chorus and their conductor David Temple for an evening of singing and exploration. These rehearsals are free and open to all, either as a one-off or if you are thinking of joining the Chorus. Music is provided if you don't have your own. Please arrive from 7:00 for a 7:30 sharp start.

Because of our busy schedule we need to increase our pool of singers, so we are actively looking for new Chorus members. If you love singing and want to find a good choir why not come and try Hertfordshire Chorus? We have a large number of young members and are always looking for good singers of all ages to join us. We are very friendly and welcoming and sing a wide range of music from new commissions to classic favourites, in top local, London and national venues. We also provide choirs and small groups of singers for gigs and recordings - we supported Gareth Malone's South Oxhey Community Choir (it was during a Hertfordshire Chorus concert at St Albans Abbey that they sang Barber's *Agnus Dei* in the TV programme), we featured on the Coldstream Guards' no. 1 album *Pride of the Nation*, and Hertfordshire Chorus singers have sung on *Spooks*, performed Christmas carols on *The One Show* and recorded in Abbey Road Studios. In January 2012 we are performing with the BBC Concert Orchestra concert at the Queen Elizabeth Hall, and we regularly sing a Christmas concert for Bob Wilson's Willow Foundation charity, and a *Last Night of the Proms* concert in Rochester Castle. All this runs alongside an exciting programme of our own concerts - you can see our 2012 concert schedule overleaf. We run optional choir tours to Europe too, most recent destinations Bruges and Siena, with the next one (in 2013) in the planning stages.

If you can't make any of these Workshop dates, you are welcome to come along any Wednesday evening, 7:30 to 10:00pm, usually at Bishops Hatfield Girls' School, Woods Avenue, Hatfield, AL10 8NL.
