David's recording work includes the BBC's *Doctor Who* at Air Studios and music for several films, most recently *A Cure for Wellness* and *Loving Vincent*. David has recently prepared a choir for concerts with Hans Zimmer. He has been chorus master for Ennio Morricone and for Andrea Bocelli and also worked with Sir Ray Davies – including at the BBC Proms in the Park - and with Noel Gallagher.

Hertfordshire Chorus is one of the finest and busiest symphonic choirs in the UK and is on your doorstep. It regularly performs with the BBC Concert Orchestra and has recently been broadcast on BBC Radio 3 and BBC Radio 2. Our latest critically acclaimed CD *Ode to a Nightingale* (Will Todd) and *Codebreaker* (James McCarthy) was recorded the BBC Concert Orchestra for Signum Records. Reviewed by Radio 3 presenter Rob Cowan "launched with their customary bright and rich tone by the Hertfordshire Chorus under their indefatigable conductor, David Temple". The Chorus performed another of its commissions *Rio Amazonas* (Roland Perrin) at the EFG London Jazz Festival.
